

# Flour Yield Token (FYT) ART Readiness Dossier

**Disclaimer:** This dossier documents *readiness* workstreams for a potential future upgrade of FYT to a MiCA **Asset-Referenced Token (ART)**. FYT is **currently a utility token** with no backing, no redemption right, and no stable-value intent. This document is not legal advice and does not constitute an ART launch notice.

#### 1) Executive Summary

- Objective: Build the controls an ART would require—before using any ART framing in public copy.
- What's in scope: Reserves & custody design, valuation policy, stabilization/redemption design (blueprint only), governance, risk, AML/KYC, reporting/assurance, disclosure cadence, and operational playbooks.
- Key dependency: The Addendum Token Issuing Agreement (bailment/custody, Release Orders, warehouse records, VAT logic) underpins physical supply governance for FYT-linked activity.
- Public stance: Until all controls are documented, tested, and approved, FYT remains a utility token.

## 2) Scope, Definitions, and Public Position

- **Scope:** Requirements and evidence typically expected for a MiCA ART program (non-exhaustive; counsel to confirm).
- Definitions:
  - Utility token (current): FYT used for network access/rewards; no reserve claim or redemption.
  - ART (potential): Token referencing assets with disclosed stabilization and (if applicable) redemption terms, reserves, custody, governance, and reporting.
- **Public position guardrails (Phase 1):** Avoid "backed," "redeemable," "stablecoin," "currency," "carbon credits/NFTs issued."



#### 3) Governance & Roles

Board & Committees: Risk & Compliance Committee; Valuation Policy Committee; Reserves
 Oversight Committee.

#### Key functions:

- o Compliance: MiCA mapping, policy upkeep, training, complaints handling.
- o **Operations:** Bailment/warehouse governance, Release Orders, inventory logs.
- o **Finance:** Valuation, impairment tests, reserve attestations coordination.
- Audit/Assurance (external): Periodic reserve and control attestations.
- Conflicts register: Maintained by Compliance; escalations to the Board.
- Outsourcing register: Labs, warehouses, logistics providers—contracts include audit and data-access clauses.

# 4) Reserves & Custody Design (Operational Backbone)

**Goal:** Show how reserves would be held, evidenced, and reported under an ART program.

- Bailment/Custody: Physical basalt (granulate/micronized) and designated unmined allocations held under bailment for the Buyer until Release Orders.
- Segregation & Identification:
  - Warehouse zones or stock IDs labeled "Held in bailment for [Buyer]."
  - For unmined allocations: bench/block maps, geologist estimates, GPS polygons, photos, chain-of-custody logs.

#### Records & Inspection:

- Warehouse records (quantity, grade/specs, location, date, RO link).
- o **Inspection rights** for auditors/regulators (notice windows, safety rules).
- Release Orders (ROs): Title moves only on RO execution per terms; VAT/Incoterms handled per flow.
- Quality: Lab Certificates of Analysis (CoA)—particle size bands, heavy-metal thresholds, batch IDs, sample methods.

Evidence pack: warehouse statements, inventory logs, RO ledger, CoAs, photo evidence, location maps.



### 5) Valuation & Pricing Policy (Draft)

**Objective:** Transparent price/NAV method if FYT ever references assets.

- Price sources (hierarchy):
  - 1. Arm's-length sales (recent, comparable grade/terms).
  - 2. Third-party market references (where available for aggregates).
  - 3. Cost-plus proxies with disclosed methodology (if market quotes thin).
- Frequency: Monthly official mark; ad-hoc if market moves ±X% or if impairment triggers.
- Adjustments:
  - Location/Incoterm differentials (EXW vs DAP).
  - Grade/spec adjustments (granulate vs micronized).
  - o Inventory state (unmined allocation priced with conservative haircut).
- **Impairment triggers:** Quality non-conformities, material logistics constraints, regulatory changes, significant demand shocks.
- Governance: Valuation Committee minutes, change-control, versioned methodology PDF.

# 6) Stabilization & Redemption Design (Blueprint Only)

Not active in Phase 1; no public promise. For ART readiness:

- **Target behavior:** Describe whether the reference basket aims for stability around a disclosed reference measure (not "peg" language unless true).
- Mechanisms (if implemented):
  - Creation/redemption windows; fees; processing timelines; holiday calendars.
  - o Liquidity buffers (cash or equivalents) and drawdown rules.
  - o Shortfall management (haircuts, queues, communication protocol).
- **Transparency:** Publish daily/weekly reserve composition, monthly valuation notes, incident reports.
- **Consumer outcomes:** Clear holder rights, T&Cs, and complaints path.



### 7) AML/CFT & Onboarding Framework

- KYC tiers: Lite (view/read), Standard (utility usage), Enhanced (higher limits).
- Screening: Sanctions (UN/EU/US), PEPs, adverse media.
- Travel Rule: If/when applicable—policy and vendor integration plan.
- **Record retention:** Per jurisdiction; data minimization & privacy by design.
- SAR/STR process: Triggers, escalation timelines, regulator contact points.

#### 8) Risk Management

- Categories: Market/price, Liquidity, Operational, Legal/Regulatory, Custody/Title, Counterparty, Technology/Security.
- **Registers:** Risk register with owner, severity, mitigation, residual risk.
- BCP/DR: RTO/RPO targets; redundant data; manual fallbacks for RO issuance; emergency communications plan.

## 9) Reporting, Assurance & Disclosures

- Public cadence:
  - Monthly reserve report (quantities by state/location + valuation notes).
  - Quarterly controls report summary.
  - o **Annual** independent assurance (reserve existence/controls).
- Open data: Read-only endpoints for basic stock metrics and RO counts.
- **Incidents:** 72-hour disclosure rule of thumb for material reserve/control events (align with counsel).

# 10) Significant ART Readiness (if thresholds are met)

- Threshold watch: Monitor supply/holder/transaction metrics tied to "significant" obligations.
- Uplift plan: Additional governance, capital, reporting, and supervisory engagement if classification changes.



#### 11) Complaints, Conflicts & Communications

- **Complaints:** Web form, SLA (ack 48h / resolve 15 business days), escalation matrix, ombuds options.
- Conflicts: Public summary of key conflicts and mitigations; periodic review.
- Marketing guardrails: Pre-clear all copy; maintain "do/don't" lexicon; archive approvals.

#### 12) Data Protection & Privacy

- Lawful bases: KYC/AML compliance, contract performance, legitimate interests.
- **DPIA:** For high-risk processing (e.g., chain-of-custody imagery with location data).
- Vendors: Security due diligence, SCCs where required, audit rights.

#### 13) Wind-Down & Resolution (If ART implemented later)

- Triggers: Regulatory direction, insolvency, prolonged shortfall.
- Actions: Freeze creations/redemptions, publish timetable and FAQs, liquidate reserves per waterfall, distribute per T&Cs.
- **Records:** Preserve full audit trail for statutory periods.
